## Saturday Program

### Description

This program is designed to help Spanish speaking children, pre-K II and K graduates of GSS, and children who have attended GSS programs and demonstrated the talent and interest to continue their learning of Spanish to become truly bi-literate in Spanish. Children in this program should be entering kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup> grade or 2<sup>nd</sup> grade.

This program is a transitional continuation of previous developmental pre-K programs that seek to develop the abilities and attitudes of children in a sequential, orderly, age-appropriate manner. In this context of this next stage of development, emphasis will be placed on further growth in:

- reading and writing skills in Spanish with proper use of grammar and vocabulary development
- math and science skills
- cultural orientation through activities that include Spanish and Latin American art, music and customs
- socialization and group participation skills, self-esteem and self-confidence

This is a program that seeks to develop bi-literate children and requires steady attendance, consistency and participation in all the subjects in the program for the full year of three sessions.

10-week programs on Saturdays from 11:00 am to 2:00 PM.

Fall Session:	September 14 – November 16, 2013
Winter Session:	November 23, 2013 – March 8, 2014
Spring Session:	March 15 – May 24, 2014

### Fees

Fees are \$3,150 for all three sessions and include registration, all materials and a snack and are payable 50% upon registration and 50% by the first day of class. Major credit cards are accepted.
